
Overview and Quick Start

Device layout



△Note

The illustrations in the Manual are for reference only. Options may vary by device model.

Buttons and components

(1) **Receiver**: Play audio during a call.

(2) Front camera/(9) Rear camera: Take photos or record videos.

(4) Infrared blaster: Controls household appliances by sending infrared coded signals.

(5) Proximity sensor and Color temperature sensor: Automatically detects the intensity of the ambient light and adjusts the screen brightness accordingly, ensuring a userfriendly experience.

The proximity sensor automatically detects the distance between you and your phone when you make or answer a call. If you are too close to your phone, the screen will turn off to prevent accidental touches. The proximity sensor doesn't work in earphone or speaker mode.

6 Volume buttons: Adjust the volume.

7 Power button: Press and hold the button to power on or off your phone.

Note

When your phone can't work properly, press and hold the Power button and Volume down button for at least 10 seconds to force restart it.

(3) Fingerprint sensor: Identifies your fingerprints, enabling you to unlock your phone without a password.

OUSB port: A standardized interface for connecting your device to earphones, charger, computer, or other compatible device.

(1) **Speaker**: Used to play audio.

12 Flash: Produces a brief burst of light.

4 Laser focusing sensor: Assists in achieving accurate and quick autofocus.

(b) Main microphone/③ Secondary microphone/③ Third **microphone**: Transfers sound during a call.

6 SIM card tray: Used to insert or remove the SIM card.

SIM card eject hole: Insert an eject pin into the hole, push it all the way into the hole until the tray ejects, and then pull the tray out.

Set up and get started


Insert a SIM card

ANote: Depending on your region or carrier, you may get a single or dual SIM phone, but the differences between the two versions are not fully covered in the Manual. The illustrations in the Manual are for reference only. Options may vary by device model.


You can insert a nano-SIM card (SIM 1 or SIM 2) with no need to turn your device off. When turned on, it will automatically identify whether you have inserted a nano-SIM card (SIM 1 or SIM 2). Your device uses nano-SIM cards (SIM 1 or SIM 2). 1. Insert an eject pin into the hole, push it all the way into the hole until the tray ejects, and then pull the tray out.



2. Place your nano-SIM card into the SIM 1 or SIM 2 holder in the direction of the arrow as shown in the illustration. Make sure to align the angled corner to the notch on the holder.



3. Hold your device face up, and then slide the tray all the way into the slot in the direction as indicated by the arrow.



∕∆Note

1. Do not remove the back cover to avoid damaging your device.

2. Do not insert the nano-SIM card (SIM 1 or SIM 2) directly into the slot of your phone.

3. Trying to trim the nano-SIM card yourself may lead to card damage or cause serious damage to your device. If the nano-SIM card (SIM 1 or SIM 2) doesn't match your device, go to your carrier and request a replacement with a standard-sized card.

4. Your device adopts a dual-SIM dual-standby single-pass solution, which means you can't use both SIM cards for calls or data services simultaneously.

• During a call made with one SIM card, the other SIM card will be temporarily disabled. If someone makes a call to this line, they will hear prompts, such as "The number you have dialed is not in service" or "The subscriber you have dialed is not available. Please try again later".

 \cdot When one SIM card is connected to the data network, the other SIM card is unable to access data services.


This is caused by the device design and has nothing to do with the carrier's network conditions. By using a single chip in your device, this design greatly enhances battery life and minimizes power consumption. To receive reminders for missed calls, contact your carrier to enable missed call notifications, incoming call notifications, and secretary services.

Antenna

Your device is equipped with a built-in antenna. Don't touch the antenna when it is transmitting or receiving signals. Touching the antenna may compromise the communications quality, cause your device to function at an unnecessarily high power level, as well as shorten the battery life.

The antenna is located inside the area marked with dotted lines as shown in the illustration below. Don't cover this area when holding your device.

Turn on or off your device

Turn off your device

To turn off your device, press and hold the Power button and Volume up button simultaneously, and tap ^U.

Turn on your device

To turn on your device, press and hold the Power button until your device vibrates.



When your device is very low on power, it will display an image of a nearly depleted battery. Charge your device to use it.

Restart your device

To restart your device, press and hold the Power button and Volume up button simultaneously, and tap **B**.

Force restart your device

Press and hold the Power button and Volume down button simultaneously for at least 10 seconds to force restart your device.

Charge your device

When the battery is running low, you will be prompted to charge your device.

Charge via a USB cable

To charge your device via a charger and a USB cable: 1. Connect the charger to your device via a USB cable.

- 2. Plug the charger into a power outlet.
- 3. Disconnect the charger when your device is fully charged.

∕∆Note

To ensure charging safety, use the charger and USB cable compatible with your device.

Charge with a wireless charger

To charge your device wirelessly: 1. Place your device on the center of the wireless charger with the screen facing upwards.

- 2. Plug the charger into a power outlet.
- 3. Disconnect the charger when your device is fully charged.

Note

This feature is only available on devices that support wireless charging.

Connect to earphones

You can connect earphones to your device to listen to music or watch movies in private.

Connect to wireless earphones

Method:

1. Turn on the wireless earphones and make sure they are in discovery mode.

2. Use your device to search for and pair with these earphones in the following ways:

2.1 Go to **Settings > Bluetooth** and turn on **Bluetooth**.

2.2 Tap the name of the Bluetooth device to be paired with your device in **Available devices**.

2.3 Follow the on-screen instructions to connect.3. Once connected, the **Bluetooth** screen will display the connected device.

△Note

The steps may vary depending on the earphones. Refer to the earphone manual for details.

Connect to wired earphones

Method: Plug the earphones directly into the earphone jack and ensure they are securely plugged in.

Note

Some devices have a combined USB and earphone jack.

Adjust the volume

When you make or answer calls or stream multimedia files on your device, you can use the side buttons to turn the volume up or down.

Press and hold the volume buttons to adjust the volume

When you stream multimedia files on your device, press the Volume up or down button to turn the volume up or down.

Quickly mute your device

When your device rings for an incoming call or alarm, press and hold the Volume down button to quickly mute it.
When there is an incoming call, flip your device to quickly mute it.

Select a language

Select a language during the setup

When you turn on your device for the first time, you can select a language from the setup wizard based on your preferences. Method:

- 1. Tap **▼**.
- 2. Select a language.
- 3. Tap **Start**.

Set the system language and region

When you are on a trip or have relocated to a different area and want to change the language or region, go to **Settings > System management > Languages & input**.

• To change the system language:

1. Tap Language > +.

2. Select the language you want to add and tap **Change**.

 \cdot To change the system language that has been added, tap the language you want to change in the language list.

· To remove a language from the list, tap **Language** > \square > \bigcirc > \checkmark

∕∆Note

To remove a language, make sure there are at least two languages in the list.

To change the language for a certain app:
1. Tap **App language**.
2. Tap the app for which you want to change language.
3. Select a language from the language list.

△Note

This feature is available only for apps that support language selection.

· To change to a different region:

1. Tap **Region**.

2. Enter the region you want to change to in the search bar.

3. Select a region from the region list.

Connect to the internet

You can connect your device to a Wi-Fi network or mobile network.

Connect to a Wi-Fi network

Method:

Turn on Wi-Fi by using the following methods:
 Swipe down from the top of the screen to open Control center, and tap [¬].
 Go to Settings > Wi-Fi, and turn on Wi-Fi.
 Go to Settings > Wi-Fi, and tap a network to connect to it.
 A indicates that a Wi-Fi password is required.

Use mobile data

Method:

 \cdot Swipe down from the top of the screen to open Control center, and tap \uparrow_{\downarrow} .

• Go to Settings > SIM card & mobile network, and turn on Mobile data.

△Note

 After Mobile data is enabled, you can access apps that require an internet connection such as Browser and Email over the mobile network.
 Charges may apply. For details, contact your carrier.

Transfer files

Clone data from your old phone to a new one

To do so, go to **EasyShare > Phone clone**

Phone clone allows you to migrate data from your old phone to a new one without consuming any data.

On the old phone:

1. Tap 🔍 . 2. Generate a QR code. 3. Display the QR code to the new phone for it to scan so as to pair up with the old phone. 4. Select the files you want to clone. 5. Tap **Start cloning**.

On the new phone:

- 1. Tap 💷.
- 2. Select the type of the old phone (iPhone or Android).

3. Scan the QR code to connect to the old phone.

4. Receive files.

2. If the old phone is an iPhone, make sure EasyShare has been installed before transferring files.

3. When file transfer is complete, the data of the same apps on the new phone will be overwritten.

Send or receive files wirelessly

To do so, go to **EasyShare > File transfer**

Take Android-powered devices for example:

On the sending device:

Tap
 Select files.
 Generate a QR code.
 Display the QR code to the receiving device for it to scan so as to pair up with the sending device.
 Tap Send.

• On the receiving device:

1. Tap \mathfrak{S} on the main screen.

2. Scan the QR code on the sending device to connect to it.

3. Receive files.

Transfer files between your computer and phone with a USB cable

• Connect your phone to a Windows computer with a USB

cable

Method:

1. Connect your phone to your computer with a USB cable.

2. Pull down the notification bar on your phone.

Tap the "Charging this device via USB" notification.
 Select File transfer.

5. Double-click on "This PC" on your computer to view the connected device.

6. Double-click to access the device and copy or manage files on your phone.

△Note

 To ensure the proper functioning of this feature, it is necessary to install Windows Media Player 11 or a higher version on Windows XP computers. This is not a prerequisite for Windows 7 or newer operating systems.
 The button name may vary by computer.

• Connect your phone to a Mac computer with a USB cable

Method:

- 1. Connect your phone to your computer with a USB cable.
- 2. Download the MTP tool on your computer.
- 3. Locate AndroidFileTransfer.dmg and double-click to open it.
- 4. Double-click the Android robot icon.
- 5. Copy or manage files on your phone.

Manage your account

Sign in to your account

to sign in to your account (available in some countries).
Go to Settings > Users & accounts, and tap

your Google account.

2. Modify your profile or link the account to an email address.

Add an account

Go to **Settings > Users & accounts**, tap + to select an account type, and follow the on-screen instructions to add the account.

Set up system navigation modes

Gesture navigation

To return to the previous screen, go back to the home screen, and switch between open apps with gestures, go to **Settings** > **System management** > **System navigation**, and select **Gesture navigation**.

Do any of the following as needed:

• To return to the previous screen: Swipe inward from the left or right edge of the screen.

• To go back to the home screen: Swipe up from the bottom of the screen.

- To access the Recent apps screen: Swipe up from the bottom and hold.
- · To close a background app: Go to the Recent apps screen, and tap \times .

Note

When an app is locked, tapping × won't close it.

3-button navigation

To return to the previous screen, go back to the home screen, and switch between open apps with buttons, go to **Settings** > **System management** > **System navigation**, and select **3-button navigation**.

Do any of the following as needed:

- $\cdot < < < :$ Return to the previous screen.
- \cdot O: Go back to the home screen.
- $\cdot \equiv /\Box$: Access the Recent apps screen.

Change UI colors

You can change the UI color of your device.

Method:

Go to Settings > Home screen, lock screen & wallpaper > Color and style, and enable System and app UI color.
 Select a color from the preset colors or the wallpaper.
 To restore to the original system and app UI color, disable System and app UI color.

△Note

All illustrations in this Manual show the default UI colors of the device with **System and app UI color** disabled. The illustrations are for reference only. The UI colors may be different on specific devices.

Change the wallpaper

You can change the theme or wallpaper of your device.

Change the theme

Method: 1. Go to **Settings > Home screen, lock screen & wallpaper > Theme**. 2. Select a theme.

Change the wallpaper

Method 1:

1. Go to Settings > Home screen, lock screen & wallpaper > Wallpaper.

2. Do any of the following:

- · Select a preloaded wallpaper.
- Tap I to select a desired image as the wallpaper.

Automatically adjust the screen brightness

You can adjust it by using the following methods:

 \cdot Swipe down from the top of the screen to open Control center, and tap \square .

· Go to Settings > Display & brightness, and turn on Autobrightness.

Adjust the font size and style

Adjust fonts:

Method:

1. Go to Settings > Display & brightness > Font & display size. 2. Do any of the following:

- To enlarge or reduce the font size, drag under **Font size**.
- To enlarge or reduce the size of displayed content, drag under **Display size**.
- · To make all fonts appear with bold weight, tap **Bold font**.

Change the font style

Method:

1. Go to Settings > Display & brightness > Font style.

- 2. Do the following:
- · Select a preloaded style.
- · Tap **Download more** to download a preferred style.

Enter text

Enter text on your device

To enter text, tap the input box, which will bring up the keypad.

Copy and paste text

Method:

- 1. Tap and hold the text to be copied.
- 2. Drag the cursor to select content.
- 3. Tap **Copy**.
- 4. Tap and hold at the area for pasting text.
- 5. Tap **Paste**.

Screenshots and screen recording

How to take a screenshot

To take a screenshot:

Method 1:

Press and hold the Power button and the Volume down button to take a quick screenshot.

Method 2: Swipe down with three fingers to take a quick screenshot. To disable this feature, go to **Settings > Shortcuts &** accessibility > S-capture, and disable Gesture screenshot.

△Note

This feature is not supported in Super Battery Saver mode.

Method 3:

1. Swipe down from the top of the screen to open Control center.

2. Tap **S-capture**.

• S-capture

To record the screen:

1. Tap **Record screen**.

2. During your first use, tap **Start screen recording**.

To change the screen recording settings, go to **Settings** > **Shortcuts & accessibility** > **S-capture**.

- 3. Tap to start recording and to pause recording.
- 4. Tap to stop recording.

∕∆Note

The recording will be stopped and saved automatically when the duration reaches 59 minutes 59 seconds or when the screen is off for 60 seconds during the recording.

To take a long screenshot:

1. Tap Long screenshot.

2. Drag the top handle upward to set the starting point of the long screen.

3. Swipe up on the screen until you have captured all or as much of the screen as you want.

4. Tap **Save**.

To take a marquee screenshot:

- 1. Tap Area screenshot.
- 2. Drag the marquee to select the area to be captured.

3. Tap 🗎.

To record an animation:

- 1. Tap **Record animation**.
- 2. Drag the marquee to select the area to be recorded.
- 3. Tap 🕨.
- 4. Tap 🗖.

[∧]Note

The recording can't be longer than 15 seconds, and it will be automatically saved as a GIF animation.

Control center features

You can quickly access frequently used shortcuts, view system notifications, and more from the Control center.


Open or close the Control center

Method:

 \cdot To open the Control center, swipe down from the top of the screen.

· To close the Control center, swipe up on the screen.


- · To delete a notification, swipe left on it (available for some notifications).

Swipe down from the top of the screen to open the Control center and swipe down again to expand the shortcuts panel.

Lock screen features

You can lock or unlock your screen, and configure the lock screen in the following ways.

Lock your screen

To lock your screen:

• Press the Power button to manually lock the screen.

• Go to **Settings > Display & brightness > Screen timeout**, and select a preferred duration. The screen will lock automatically after it has been inactive for the selected duration.

Configure the lock screen

To change the lock screen style and create a lock screen shortcut:

Method:

1. Go to Settings > Home screen, lock screen & wallpaper > Lock screen settings.

2. Do any of the following:

• To set the lock screen clock, date style, or features that can be quickly started on the lock screen, go to **Custom lock screen**.

• To change the lock screen wallpaper with the theme, enable **Change lock screen wallpaper based on theme**.

∕∆Note

Only static wallpapers can change along with themes.

• To open the Control center from the lock screen, enable **Open Control center from the lock screen**.

Unlock your device

If you haven't set up a password lock, fingerprint lock, or face lock, when the screen is locked and turned on, swipe up to unlock your device.

If you have set up a password lock, fingerprint lock, or face lock, when the screen is locked and turned on, unlock your device in the following ways:

- · Swipe up on the screen and enter your lock screen password.
- Touch the fingerprint sensor using a registered fingerprint.

• Align your face with the screen. Your device will unlock once your face is recognized.

Note

To learn about how to set up a password lock, face lock, or fingerprint lock, go to **Settings > Password & security** in the Manual.

Edit home screen

Add an app or a widget to the home screen

Add an app to the home screen

Method:

Swipe up on the home screen to access the **Apps** screen.
 Tap and hold an app, drag it to the desired position on the home screen, and then lift your finger.

Add a widget to the home screen

Method:

1. Go to the **Widgets** screen in the following ways:

• Tap and hold a blank area on the home screen, and tap **Widgets**.

· Swipe up on the home screen, and tap Widgets.

2. Tap and hold a widget, drag it to the desired position on the home screen, and then lift your finger.

Manage the home screen

Create an app folder

Group your apps for better management as follows:

Method:

- 1. Tap and hold an app.
- 2. Drag the app to another app and lift your finger to automatically create a folder.
- 3. Do any of the following:
- To rename the folder, tap and hold the folder, and tap **Rename**.
- To quickly open an app, tap and hold the folder, and tap **Enlarge folder**.
- To dissolve the folder, tap and hold the folder, and tap **Dissolve**

folder.

Remove or uninstall an app

Remove or uninstall an app in the following ways:

- · Tap and hold the app, and tap **Remove** or **D**.
- Pinch your fingers or tap and hold a blank area on the home screen to access editing mode, select the app you want to remove, and then tap **Remove**.

Remove a widget

Method:

- · Tap and hold a widget, and then tap **Remove**.
- Pinch your fingers or tap and hold a blank area on the home screen to access editing mode, select the widget you want to remove, and then tap **Remove**.

Rearrange pages on the home screen

Method:

1. Pinch your fingers or tap and hold a blank area on the home screen to enter editing mode.

2. Tap and hold a thumbnail and drag it to the desired position, and then lift your finger.

Use Smart split

You can enable split-screen mode to use two apps on the same screen. With split-screen mode enabled, incoming messages from another app appear as floating icons. Tapping the icon splits the screen into two, allowing you to view messages from both apps simultaneously.

Enable split-screen mode

Enable split-screen for apps that support this mode in the following ways:

Method 1: 1. Access the Recent apps screen. 2. Tap > .

Method 2:

If you have enabled the "Slide up with three fingers to split screen" feature, split the screen by sliding up with three fingers. To enable the "Slide up with three fingers to split screen" feature, go to **Settings > Shortcuts & accessibility > screen-split** and enable **Slide up with three fingers to split screen**.

Method 3:

 Swipe down from the top of the screen to open Control center and swipe down again to expand the shortcuts panel.
 Tap **Split-screen**.

Upgrade your device

Note

Unauthorized ROM flashing or system updates may incur security risks. You are advised to back up your data before upgrading the system.

Automatically detect updates

To detect updates:

• Go to **Settings > System update**. Your device will automatically detect available updates. You can download and install them as needed.

· Go to **Settings** > **System update** > : > **Upgrade settings**, and turn on **Smart Upgrade**. This allows your device to automatically download and install updates via Wi-Fi during idle hours at night.

∕∆Note

1. You must connect your device to the internet to use this feature.

2. System updates may incur a large amount of data. You are advised to download them over Wi-Fi.

3. If there are no available updates, it indicates that your device is already up to date.

• Upgrade your device with an existing package

To upgrade your device with an existing package: 1. Go to **Settings > System update > i > Upgrade settings > Local upgrade**. Your device will automatically scan for available packages.

2. Select the upgrade package to be installed, and tap **Start upgrade**.

∕∆Note

A system update package is required on your device to use this option.

Find devices

To remotely locate, find, lock, or erase your device, make sure your device:

- \cdot Is powered on.
- · Has Find My Device enabled.
- · Is signed in to your Google account.
- \cdot Is connected to a network.
- \cdot Has Location enabled.
- \cdot Is visible on Google Play.

Remotely find and erase your device

Method:

 Go to Settings > Password & security > Find My Device, tap 'Find My Device' website on your device or access the Find My Device website from Google, and sign in to your Google account.
 Your lost device gets a notification.

3. You will get notified of the approximate location or the last known location of your device.

4. Follow the on-screen instructions to select what you want to do.

Note

1. To learn more about other options, go to **Settings > Password & security > Find My Device > Learn more**.

2. You must connect your device to the internet to use this feature.

Use accessibility shortcuts

You can quickly enable an accessibility feature with a floating button from Accessibility.

Method:

 Go to Settings > Shortcuts & accessibility > Accessibility to enable accessibility features, such as TalkBack.
 Tap the floating button to use the accessibility features.
 To change the position, size, and transparency of the floating button, go to Accessibility > Accessibility shortcuts > Accessibility button.

Tap 🕥 to access the iManager app to free up space, view data usage, scan for vulnerabilities, and more.

Manage your device

Do any of the following:

- To detect and optimize your device status, tap **Optimize**.
